



**Notice of Race for the 2011/2012 Drummoyne Junior Sailing Club Sailing Season**

***Organising Authority: Drummoyne Sailing Club***

**1. Rules**

The events conducted by the Drummoyne Junior Sailing Club during the 2011/2012 Sailing Season will be governed by the rules defined by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, as amended by the prescriptions and special regulations of Yachting Australia (YA), the current class rules, this notice of race and the Sailing Instructions.

**2. Calendar**

- 2.1. If a race is abandoned, it will NOT be re-sailed except in the case of a club championship is, it will then be sailed at the next sailing date unless otherwise notified by the Race Committee.
- 2.2. The official calendar will be in the Sailing Instructions.

**3. Eligibility and Entry**

- 3.1. Classes of DJSC are: Sabot Silver, Sabot Gold 2-Up, Sabot Gold 1-Up, Flying 11, Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser Full Rig and Cherub.
- 3.2. DJSC will start and finish OK Dinghies and Historical Skiffs who are responsible for their own divisions.
- 3.3. All Skippers and Crew must be financial members of Drummoyne Junior Sailing Club (DJSC) and Drummoyne Sailing Club (DSC).
- 3.4. Change of crew or boat must be notified to the Principal Race Officer or Race Secretary in writing prior to the race.
- 3.5. The 2011/2012 DSC Junior Division Membership form along with the entry form must be completed and signed before sailing the first race.

**4. Measurement**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate if requested by the race committee.

**5. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing instructions will be available on the DSC website no later than 1 week prior to the first scheduled race.

**6. Scoring**

This will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions

**7. Support Boats**

Support boats shall stay clear of the fleet unless immediate assistance is required. Coaching is not permitted except for the silver fleet.

**8. Courses**

Courses will be available in the sailing instructions

**9. Electronic Communication**

No boat shall make or receive electronic communication while racing. This includes mobile phones and radio communication.

**10. Race Committee**

The race committee will be made up of the divisional PRO, divisional race secretary and divisional handicapper. All communication to the race committee is to be made via the divisional race secretary.



## 11. Prizes

11.1. Prizes may be awarded to the Sabot Gold 1-Up, Sabot Gold 2-Up, Cherub, Lasers and OK Dinghy:

Summer Point score:	Lowest points on handicap in all fleets after Christmas with the worst race discarded.	Lowest points on handicap in all fleets after Christmas with the worst two races discarded.
Fastest Time Point score	Lowest points on scratch in all fleets over the season with the three worst races discarded.	Lowest points on scratch in all fleets over the season with the six worst races discarded.
Season Point score	Lowest points on handicap in all fleets over the season with the three worst races discarded	Lowest points on handicap in all fleets over the season with the six worst races discarded
Sprints	Lowest points on handicap and scratch for cherubs and flying 11 in the selected sprints race, with the worst two races discarded.	Lowest points on handicap and scratch in the selected sprints race, with the worst two races discarded.

- 11.2. To be eligible for club championship points in the nominated class, sailors must;
- Represent DJSC exclusively when attending Association events for the nominated class.
  - Have sailed at least 70% of the club calendar races for the nominated class, except where agreed on application in writing with the DJSC Race Committee.
  - The race committee shall be entitled to use their discretion when assessing eligibility, especially when the DJSC club member has nominally fulfilled the intent of clauses 11.2 (a) and (b) . Where the intent of (a) and (b) above has been nominally fulfilled, the discretion of the race committee shall be exercised to achieve inclusion of the respective DJSC members in the club championship in the interests of encouraging junior participation in sailing.

## 12. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the season entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the 2011/2012 Sailing Season.

## 13. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance, for the duration of the season with a minimum cover of A\$10 000 000.
